Why Is Gymnastics Expensive?

Gymnastics is a specialized sport with significant operational costs. Unlike many other activities, gymnastics clubs require a dedicated, fully equipped facility that cannot be shared or easily rented part-time.

- Facility costs and utilities to operate a full-time training space
- Equipment purchases and maintenance to ensure safety and quality
- Alberta Gymnastics Federation (AGF) fees for club and athlete participation
- Coach certification, insurance, and ongoing training

Our coaches are trained through the National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) and must stay up to date on certifications.

Our coaches are paid, professional staff — not volunteers.
